

ORDINANCE NO. 91 OF 1972

BY MAYOR ALLEN:

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 184 of 1957 of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, by changing the zoning classification of a tract of land on the West side of Allen Avenue, between Looney and Ashton Streets, from R-5, Multiple Family Residence District, to B-3, Community Business District.

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in legal and regular session convened, that Ordinance No. 184 of 1957 is hereby amended to provide that property beginning at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Allen Avenue and Looney Street and extending Southward 278.7 feet along the West line of Allen Avenue to a point 30 feet North of the Southern boundary of the property owned by the Caddo Investment Company, thence West 98.7 feet to the South line of Looney Street, thence North 278.7 feet, thence East 98.7 feet to the point of beginning, be and the same is hereby changed from R-5, Multiple Family Residence District, to B-3, Community Business District.
