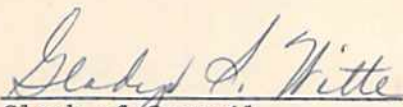

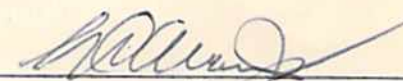

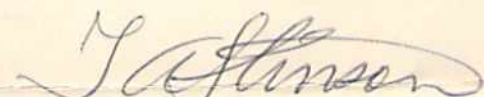
BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in due, legal and regular session convened, that all private security agencies, persons, organizations, corporations or partnerships shall, if doing business within the City of Shreveport, submit to the Department of Public Safety through either the Commissioner or Chief of Police, their uniform, together with such equipment as each individual may carry and for approval by said department through the Commissioner and/or the Chief of Police.
