ORDINANCE NO. 104 of 1972

By Commissioner Hathaway:

An Ordinance closing and abandoning the north south twenty foot (20') alley and part of the east west twenty foot (20') alley in block 13, East Gladstone Subd.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shreveport has received a petition to close and abandon the North-South twenty foot (20') alley and that part of the East west twenty foot (20') alley which west of Youree Drive Extension, all in Block 13 of East Gladstone Subdivision, requesting the closure and abandonment of said twenty foot (20') alleys, and

WHEREAS, owners of all property abutting the said twenty foot (20') alleys have signed this petition requesting the closure and abandonment; and

WHEREAS, a drainage ditch and certain utilities occupy a part of the above described alleys, there is a need to retain a drainage and utility easement along said alleys.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that the North South twenty foot (20') alley and that part of the East West twenty (20') alley which lies west of youree Drive Extension, all in Block 13 of East Gladstone Subdivision, be and they are hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that drainage and utility easements be retained along the above described alleys to be closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be filed in the records of the Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
