

ORDINANCE NO. 89 OF 1972

An Ordinance Closing and Abandoning Part of
Old Hearne Avenue Lying Southerly of Holly-
wood Avenue and the Northwestern Line of
New Hearne Avenue (U. S. 171)

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shreveport has received a petition signed by the owners of all property abutting that part of old Hearne Avenue as recorded on map in Book 300, Page 494, conveyance records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and lying between the Southerly line of Hollywood Avenue and the Northwestern line of new Hearne Avenue (U. S. 171) requesting the closure and abandonment of that part of said old Hearne Avenue; and

WHEREAS, proposed improvements along Hollywood Avenue require that we retain the Northwesternly fifteen feet (15') of the above described old Hearne Avenue and proposed development along new Hearne Avenue (U. S. 171) require that we retain that part of the Southerly end of old Hearne Avenue, being a ten foot (10') strip measured parallel to the existing Northwesternly right of way line of new Hearne Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this closure and abandonment will best serve all concerned closed and abandoned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that old Hearne Avenue as recorded on map in Book 300, Page 494, conveyance records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and lying between the Southerly line of Hollywood Avenue and the Northwesternly line of new Hearne Avenue (U. S. 171), excepting that part retained for future construction along Hearne Avenue and Hollywood Avenue as described above, be and

it is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be
filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
