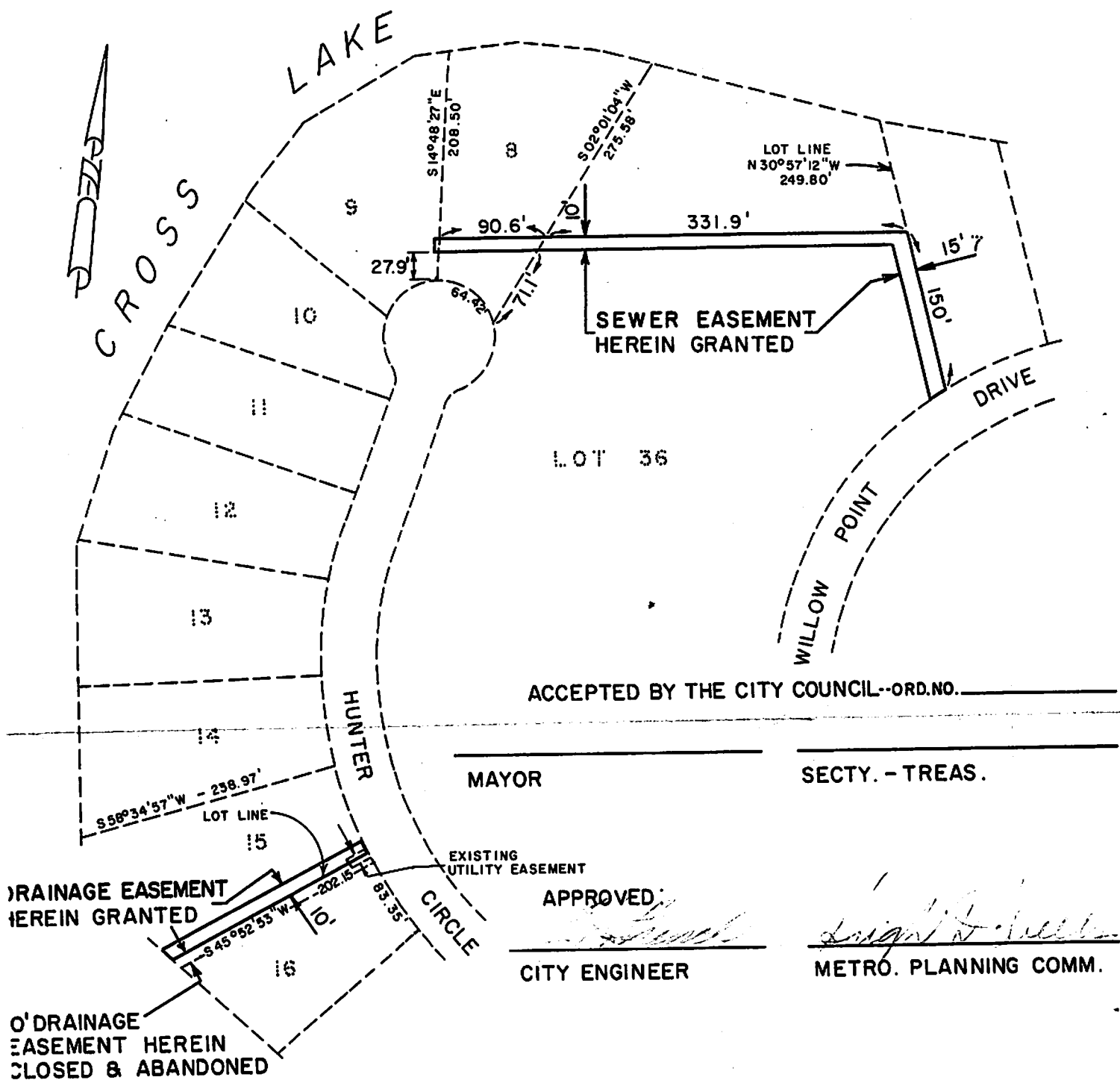
An Ordinance Closing and Abandoning a Ten Foot

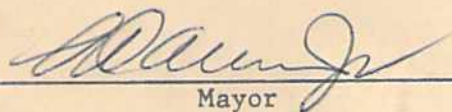

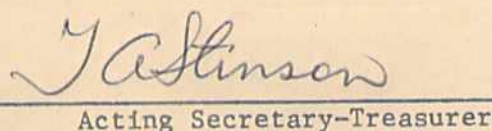

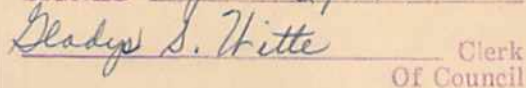
