

ORDINANCE NO. 142 of 1972

By MR. D'ARTOIS:

An Ordinance amending paragraph 7 of Section 1 of the Code of Shreveport of 1955 providing for the working out of fines assessed in the City Court of the City of Shreveport

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in regular and legal session convened:

Section 1: That paragraph 7 of Section 1 of the Code of Shreveport of 1955 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1 - 7. Working out fines.

In default of payment of any fine imposed upon the conviction of any person for violating any provision of this Code or other Ordinance of the City of Shreveport, the party or person convicted shall be ordered to work the fine out upon the streets and alleys or other public works of the City of Shreveport at the rate of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per day, for each day of labor performed.

SECTION 2: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or laws or parts of ordinances and laws in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
