

ORDINANCE NO. 165 OF 1972

ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING A PART
OF A TWENTY (20') FOOT ALLEY IN BLOCK 46,
CITY OF SHREVEPORT

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport has received a petition requesting the closure and abandonment of that part of the twenty (20') foot alley in Block 46 of the City of Shreveport that abuts Lots 3 through 7, both inclusive, and Lots 11 through 15, both inclusive, all in said Block 46, and

WHEREAS, all owners of that part of the twenty (20') foot alley described above have signed the petition requesting this closure and abandonment, and

WHEREAS, that part of the twenty (20') foot alley to be closed and abandoned is not presently open to vehicular traffic, and the Easterly end of the dedication for the said alley presently terminates at the I-20 ramp to Spring Street, and

WHEREAS, this closure and abandonment will best serve all concerned closed and abandoned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that that part of the twenty (20') foot alley which abuts Lots 3 through 7, both inclusive, and Lots 11 through 15, both inclusive, be and it is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
