

ORDINANCE NO. 157 OF 1972

BY MAYOR ALLEN:

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 184 of 1957 of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, by changing the zoning classification of five lots located on the West side of Jewella Road, between Claiborne Avenue and Woodrow Street, from R-1, One-Family Residence District, to B-2, Neighborhood Business District.

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in legal and regular session convened, that Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, Rose Park Subdivision, located on the West side of Jewella Avenue, between Claiborne Avenue and Woodrow Street, Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, be and the same are hereby changed from R-1, One-Family Residence District, to B-2, Neighborhood Business District.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Etc., that a six (6) foot masonry wall be constructed along the entire West property line of these five lots, prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy for any commercial use of the lots.

October 10, 1972 - Having passed first reading on September 26, 1972, was read by title and on motion, ordered passed to third reading. Read the third time in full and as read, adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Mayor Allen, Commissioners Burton, D'Artois, Collins and Hathaway 5. Nays: None.
