

ORDINANCE NO. 95 OF 1972

By Mr. D'Artois:

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A
TWO HOUR PARKING ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF LOUISIANA AVENUE
BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF LAKE STREET AND EXTENDING SOUTH
FOR A DISTANCE OF EIGHTY FOUR (84) FEET.

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in
regular and legal session convened, that the space on the East side of
Louisiana Avenue, beginning at the intersection of Lake Street and extending
in a Southerly direction for approximately eighty four (84) feet, is hereby
created and established a Two-Hour Parking Zone and it shall hereafter be
unlawful for any person to park any vehicle for a longer period of time
than two hours in said zone.
