

ORDINANCE NO. 147 OF 1972

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDON-
ING DUNLAP STREET BETWEEN YALE
AVENUE AND THE ALLEY TO THE EAST
OF YALE AVENUE

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport has received a request to close and abandon Dunlap Street between Yale Avenue and the alley to the East of Yale Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this street presently dead ends at an alley, it will not appreciably affect the traffic pattern in the alley; and

WHEREAS, the closure and abandonment of this street will allow Orthodox Hebrew Rest which abuts both sides of this street to join their properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that Dunlap Street between Yale Avenue and the alley to the East of Yale Avenue be and it is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc. that this Ordinance be filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that a utility easement be retained along that part of Dunlap Street herein closed and abandoned.
