

ORDINANCE NO. 77 OF 1972

By Commissioner Hathaway:

AN ORDINANCE approving and accepting the work of paving

Stonewall Avenue from Portland Avenue to I-20

and authorizing payment of the contractor.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Shreveport has made a final inspection of the paving of Stonewall Avenue from Portland Avenue to I-20,

done by Ray Gray Construction Company under a contract with the City of Shreveport, dated December 30, 1971, and authorized by Resolution No. 652 of 1971 of the City of Shreveport, and has issued his certificate that the work has been fully, finally and satisfactorily performed and completed by the said contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that it does hereby approve and accept the work performed by Ray Gray Construction Company in paving Stonewall Avenue from Portland Avenue to I-20

under contract with the City of Shreveport, dated December 30, 1971, and the Secretary-Treasurer of the City of Shreveport is hereby authorized and instructed to pay the said contractor in full the balance due under the terms of said contract.
