ORDINANCE NO. 66 OF 1972

An Ordinance Closing and Abandoning The Thirty  
(30') Foot Street Dedication Along The South Side  
Of North Pierremont Subdivision

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shreveport has received a request to close and abandon the thirty (30') foot street dedication which exists along the South side of North Pierremont Subdivision between the East line of Gilbert Drive and the West line of Bayou Pierre, as per map in Book 450, Page 423, Conveyance Records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, this street dedication has never been used for public traffic purposes and can best serve all concerned closed and abandoned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that the thirty (30') foot street dedication which exists along the South side of North Pierremont Subdivision between the East line of Gilbert Drive and the West line of Bayou Pierre, as per map in Book 450, Page 423, Conveyance Records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, be and the same is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that a utility and drainage easement be reserved along this thirty (30') foot dedication.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
