

ORDINANCE NO. 27 OF 1972

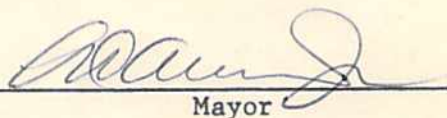

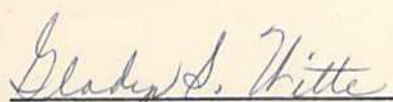
An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 184 of 1957 of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, by changing the zoning classification of property having Municipal Number 501 Stoner Avenue, Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, located in the Southwest corner of Stoner & Highland Avenue, from B-2, Neighborhood Business District to B-3-L-1, Package Liquor District.

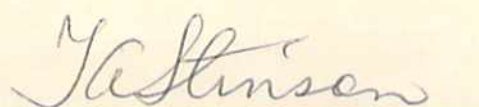
SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in legal and regular session convened, that 501 Stoner Avenue, located in a portion of the existing grocery store building in the Southwest corner of Stoner and Highland Avenue, Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, be and the same is hereby changed from B-2, Neighborhood Business District to B-3-L-1, Package Liquor District.

March 14, 1972 - Read by title and as read, passed first reading by the following vote: Ayes; Mayor Allen, Commissioners Burton, D'Artois, Collins and Hathaway 5. Nays: None.
