

ORDINANCE NO. 23 OF 1972

Ordinance To Close and Abandon a Portion of Tally Street in Tally's Subdivision

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shreveport has received a petition to close and abandon that part of Tally Street which is bounded on one side by Lots 13 and 14 and on the other side by Lots 15 and 16, all in Tally's Subdivision, as per map in Book G, Page 336, Conveyance Records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and

WHEREAS, Tally Street is presently a dead end street, this closure and abandonment will not inhibit the flow of traffic utilizing it, and

WHEREAS, this closure and abandonment will allow the owners, Church of the Holy Cross, to join these four lots, and

WHEREAS, each of the four utility companies which utilize the right of way of Tally Street for their facility have agreed to this closure and abandonment so long as a utility easement is retained along that part to be closed and abandoned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that that part of Tally Street which is bounded on one side by Lots 13 and 14 and on the other side by Lots 15 and 16, all in Tally's Subdivision, as per map in Book G, Page 336, records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, be and it is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that a utility easement be retained along that part of Tally Street to be closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
