ORDINANCE NO. 41 OF 1972

An Ordinance Closing and Abandoning The
Thirty Foot (30') Alley in Block 63 of the
City of Shreveport

By Commissioner Hathaway:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shreveport has received a petition to close and abandon the thirty foot (30') alley lying between Dixie Overland Boulevard and Lake Street, all in City Block 63 of the City of Shreveport, requesting the closure and abandonment of said thirty foot (30') alley; and

WHEREAS, all owners of property abutting the said thirty foot (30') alley have signed this petition requesting the closure and abandonment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal and regular session convened, that the thirty foot (30') alley lying between Dixie Overland Boulevard and Lake Street, all in City Block 63 of the City of Shreveport, be and it is hereby closed and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that a utility easement be retained along the said thirty foot (30') alley.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance be filed in the records of Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
