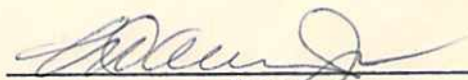

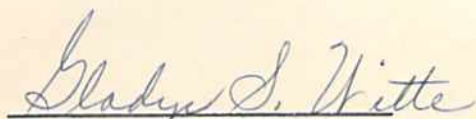
AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ANYTIME
OF THE DAY OR NIGHT ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE 1600 AND 1700 BLOCKS
OF IRVING PLACE; AND ON THE EAST SIDE OF IRVING PLACE IN THE 1800
BLOCK.

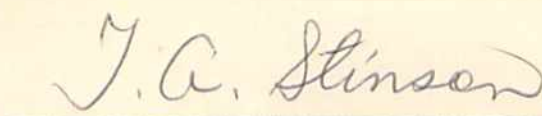
SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in
regular and legal session convened, that it shall hereafter be unlawful for
any person to park any vehicle at anytime of the day or night on the west side
of the 1600 and 1700 blocks of Irving Place; and on the east side of Irving
Place in the 1800 block.
